

# Additive (Volume)

Find volumes of solid figures composed of two non-overlapping right rectangular prisms by adding the volumes of the non-overlapping parts.

# Conversion / Convert

Change in the form of a measurement, different unit, without a change in the size or amount.

# Decimal

A number with one or more digits  
to the right of a decimal point.  
Decimal is used as another name  
for decimal fraction.

# Equivalent

Fractions that have the same  
value.



# Factors

The whole numbers that are multiplied to get a product.

# Mixed Number

A number that is written as a whole number and a fraction.

Product

The answer to a multiplication problem.

# Right Rectangular Prism

A prism with 6 rectangular faces.



# Scaling

When multiplying a given number by a fraction less than 1 results in a product smaller than the given number. When multiplying a given number by a fraction greater than 1 results in a product larger than the given number.

# Unit Fraction

A fraction that has 1 as its  
numerator.

A unit fraction names 1 equal part  
of a whole.

# Volume

The number of cubic units it takes  
to fill a figure.
